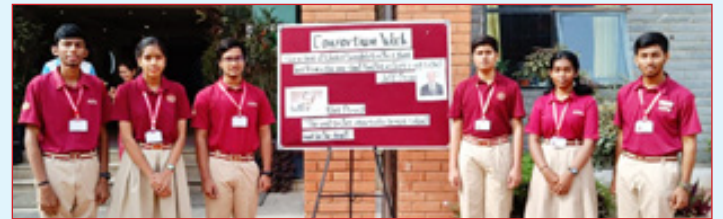
COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP JULY 26TH 2023- 4TH AUGUST 2023
